The average CPI for each year is shown in the second column. In 1959 the CPI averaged 29.3. The third column shows the change in the CPI from the previous year. In 1960 the CPI increased 1.7% over 1959. The fourth column shows the percentage increases in the CPI since the years in the first column. For example, since 1959, the CPI has risen 615.5%; since 1999 it has risen 28.4%. The fifth column shows the value of the dollar on a 1982-84 = 100 base in the respective years. In 2009 the dollar was worth 47.7 cents.

The average percentage increase over the fifty year period was 4.1%, while the average annual increase over the last ten years was 2.5%.
