ber should be paid any amount in a retirement benefit, to which he is not entitled under the applicable provisions of law governing such re-employment, such amount shall be recovered by the state retirement system paying such benefit by utilizing any recovery procedure available under the code provisions of the state retirement system covering such reemployment.

(Č) A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 145.38 OF THE REVISED CODE, IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ANY BENEFIT UNDER THIS SECTION FOR SERVICE SUBJECT TO SECTION 145.38 OF THE REVISED

CODE.

Sec. 145.38. (A) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

(1) "PERS RETIRANT" MEANS A FORMER MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS RECEIV-ING EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

(a) AGE AND SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS UNDER SECTION 145.32, 145.33, 145.34, 145.36, OR 145.46 OF THE REVISED

CODE;

(b) AGE AND SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS PAID BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER SEC-TION 145.37 OF THE REVISED CODE.

(2) "OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT" MEANS BOTH OF THE

FOLLOWING:

- (a) A FORMER MEMBER OF THE POLICE AND FIREMEN'S DISABILITY AND PENSION FUND, STATE TEACHERS RETIRE-MENT SYSTEM, SCHOOL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, STATE HIGHWAY PATROL RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OR CINCINNATI RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS RECEIVING AGE AND SERVICE, COMMUTED AGE AND SERVICE, OR DISABIL-ITY RETIREMENT BENEFITS FROM A SYSTEM OF WHICH HE IS A FORMER MEMBER;
- (b) A FORMER MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RE-TIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS RECEIVING AGE AND SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS UNDER SECTION 145.37 OF THE REVISED CODE PAID BY THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES RETIRE-MENT SYSTEM OR THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYS-TEM.
- (B)(1) SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT MAY BE EMPLOYED BY A PUBLIC EMPLOYER. IF SO EMPLOYED, THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTH-ER SYSTEM RETIRANT SHALL CONTRIBUTE TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 145.47 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND THE EMPLOYER SHALL MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SEC-TION 145,48 OF THE REVISED CODE.

(2) A PUBLIC EMPLOYER THAT EMPLOYS A PERS RETIR-ANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT, OR ENTERS INTO A CON-TRACT FOR SERVICES AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR WITH A PERS RETIRANT WHO WAS EMPLOYED BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYER AT THE TIME OF HIS RETIREMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE RETIREMENT BOARD OF THE EMPLOYMENT OR CONTRACT NOT LATER THAN THE END OF THE MONTH IN WHICH THE EMPLOYMENT OR CONTRACT COMMENCES. ANY OVERPAYMENT OF BENEFITS TO A PERS RETIRANT BY THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM RESULTING FROM DELAY OR FAILURE OF THE EMPLOYER TO GIVE THE NOTICE SHALL BE REPAID TO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BY THE EMPLOYER.

(3) ON RECEIPT OF NOTICE FROM A PUBLIC EMPLOYER THAT A PERSON WHO IS AN OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT HAS BEEN EMPLOYED, THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL NOTIFY THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF WHICH THE OTHER SYSTEM

RETIRANT WAS A MEMBER OF SUCH EMPLOYMENT.

(4) A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT WHO HAS RECEIVED HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR LESS THAN TWO MONTHS WHEN EMPLOYMENT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION COMMENCES SHALL FORFEIT HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR THE PERIOD THAT BEGINS ON THE DATE THE EMPLOYMENT COMMENCES AND ENDS ON THE DATE THAT IS TWO MONTHS AFTER THE DATE ON WHICH THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE COMMENCED. SERVICE AND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THAT PERIOD SHALL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE CALCULATION OF ANY BENEFITS PAYABLE TO THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT AND THOSE CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL BE REFUNDED ON HIS DEATH OR TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT.

- (5) ON RECEIPT OF NOTICE FROM THE POLICE AND FIREMEN'S DISABILITY AND PENSION FUND, SCHOOL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OR STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE RE-EMPLOYMENT OF A PERS RETIRANT, THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL NOT PAY, OR IF PAID, SHALL RECOVER, THE AMOUNT TO BE FORFEITED BY THE PERS RETIRANT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 742.26, 3307.381, OR 3309.341 OF THE REVISED CODE.
- (6) A PERS RETIRANT WHO ENTERS INTO A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE SERVICES AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR TO THE EMPLOYER BY WHICH HE WAS EMPLOYED AT THE TIME OF HIS RETIREMENT OR, LESS THAN TWO MONTHS AFTER HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE COMMENCES, BEGINS PROVIDING SERVICES AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT WITH ANOTHER PUBLIC EMPLOYER, SHALL FORFEIT THE PENSION PORTION OF HIS RETIREMENT BENEFIT FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE SERVICES BEGIN AND ENDING ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE SERVICES END. THE ANNUITY PORTION OF THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE

SHALL BE SUSPENDED ON THE DAY SERVICES UNDER THE CONTRACT BEGIN AND SHALL ACCUMULATE TO THE CREDIT OF THE RETIRANT TO BE PAID IN A SINGLE PAYMENT AFTER SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THE CONTRACT TERMINATE. A PERS RETIRANT SUBJECT TO DIVISION (B)(6) OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT CONTRIBUTE TO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND SHALL NOT BECOME A MEMBER OF THE SYSTEM.

(C)(1) A PERS RETIRANT EMPLOYED PURSUANT TO THIS

SECTION SHALL ELECT ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

(a) TO RECEIVE BOTH HIS COMPENSATION FOR HIS EM-

PLOYMENT AND HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE:

(b) TO RECEIVE HIS COMPENSATION FOR HIS EMPLOY-MENT AND FORFEIT THE PENSION PORTION OF HIS RETIRE-MENT ALLOWANCE.

(2) A PERS RETIRANT WHO ELECTS TO FORFEIT THE PEN-SION PORTION OF HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER DI-VISION (C)(1)(b) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BECOME A NEW MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, AND OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP, EXCEPT THAT THE NEW MEMBERSHIP DOES NOT INCLUDE SURVIVOR BENEFITS PROVIDED PURSUANT TO SECTION 145.45 OF THE REVISED CODE. THE PENSION POR-TION OF THE PERS RETIRANT'S RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL CEASE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE FIRST MONTH FOL-LOWING COMMENCEMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT AND SHALL THEREAFTER BE FORFEITED UNTIL THE FIRST DAY OF THE FIRST MONTH FOLLOWING TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT. THE ANNUITY PORTION OF THE RETIRE-MENT ALLOWANCE SHALL BE SUSPENDED ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE FIRST MONTH FOLLOWING COMMENCEMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT AND SHALL THEREAFTER ACCUMULATE TO THE CREDIT OF THE PERS RETIRANT TO BE PAID IN A SINGLE PAYMENT AFTER TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOY-MENT. THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL RESUME ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE FIRST MONTH FOLLOWING TERMINA-TION OF THE EMPLOYMENT. ON TERMINATION OF THE EM-PLOYMENT, THE PERS RETIRANT SHALL ELECT TO RECEIVE EITHER A REFUND OF HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE RETIRE-MENT SYSTEM DURING THE PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT SUB-JECT TO THIS SECTION OR A SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE BASED ON HIS CONTRIBUTIONS AND SERVICE CREDIT FOR THAT PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT.

(D)(1) THERE SHALL BE NO SUSPENSION OR FORFEITURE OF ANY PORTION OF THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANTS, OR TO PERS RETIRANTS WHO ELECT TO RECEIVE BOTH THEIR RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYMENT, SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION. ON TERMINATION OF SUCH EMPLOYMENT, THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT

MAY FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR A BENEFIT UNDER THIS DIVISION, WHICH SHALL CONSIST OF A SINGLE LIFE ANNUITY HAVING A RESERVE EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF HIS ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT AND AN EQUAL AMOUNT OF THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTIONS. THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT SHALL ELECT EITHER TO RECEIVE THE BENEFIT AS A MONTHLY ANNUITY FOR HIS LIFE OR A LUMP SUM PAYMENT DISCOUNTED TO THE PRESENT VALUE USING THE CURRENT ACTUARIAL ASSUMPTION RATE OF INTEREST, EXCEPT THAT IF HIS MONTHLY ANNUITY WOULD BE LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS PER MONTH, HE SHALL RECEIVE A LUMP SUM PAYMENT.

(2) A BENEFIT PAYABLE UNDER THIS DIVISION SHALL COMMENCE ON THE LATEST OF THE FOLLOWING:

(a) THE LAST DAY FOR WHICH COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYMENT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION WAS PAID;

(b) ATTAINMENT BY THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYS-

TEM RETIRANT OF AGE SIXTY-FIVE;

(c) IF THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT WAS PREVIOUSLY EMPLOYED UNDER THIS SECTION AND IS RECEIVING OR PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED A BENEFIT UNDER THIS DIVISION, COMPLETION OF A PERIOD OF TWELVE MONTHS SINCE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LAST BENEFIT UNDER THIS DIVISION.

(3)(a) IF A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT DIES WHILE EMPLOYED IN EMPLOYMENT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, A LUMP SUM PAYMENT CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH DIVISION (D)(1) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID TO HIS BENEFICIARY UNDER DIVISION (G) OF THIS SECTION.

(b) IF AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT RECEIVING A MONTHLY ANNUITY HAS RECEIVED LESS THAN HE WOULD HAVE RECEIVED AS A LUMP SUM PAYMENT, THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE AMOUNT HE RECEIVED AND THE AMOUNT HE WOULD HAVE RECEIVED AS A LUMP SUM PAYMENT SHALL BE PAID TO HIS BENEFICIARY UNDER DIVISION (G) OF THIS SECTION.

(4) A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT SUBJECT TO THIS DIVISION IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, DOES NOT HAVE ANY OF THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, OR OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP, EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION, AND IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE HEALTH, MEDICAL, HOSPITAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS UNDER SECTION 145.58 OF THE REVISED CODE FOR EMPLOYMENT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION. NO AMOUNT RECEIVED UNDER THIS DIVISION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN DETERMINING AN ADDITIONAL BENEFIT

UNDER SECTION 145,323 OF THE REVISED CODE OR ANY OTHER POST-RETIREMENT BENEFIT INCREASE.

(E) IF THE DISABILITY RETIREMENT OF AN OTHER SYS-TEM RETIRANT EMPLOYED UNDER THIS SECTION IS TERMI-NATED, HE SHALL BECOME A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC EM-PLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, EFFECTIVE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH NEXT FOLLOWING THE TERMINATION WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, AND OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP. IF SUCH PERSON, AFTER THE TERMINATION OF HIS DISABILITY RETIREMENT, EARNS TWO YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT UNDER THIS SYSTEM OR UNDER THE PO-LICE AND FIREMEN'S DISABILITY AND PENSION FUND. STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM, SCHOOL EMPLOY-EES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OR STATE HIGHWAY PATROL RE-TIREMENT SYSTEM, HIS PRIOR CONTRIBUTIONS AS AN OTH-ER SYSTEM RETIRANT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN-CLUDED IN HIS TOTAL SERVICE CREDIT AS A PUBLIC EM-PLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM MEMBER, AND HE SHALL FORFEIT ALL RIGHTS AND BENEFITS OF THIS SECTION. NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR OF CREDIT MAY BE GIVEN FOR ANY PERIOD OF TWELVE MONTHS.

(F) A PERS RETIRANT WHO PERFORMS SERVICES FOR A PUBLIC EMPLOYER AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT WITH THE EMPLOYER SHALL NOT MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR BECOME A MEMBER OF THE SYSTEM. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN DIVISION (B)(6) OF THIS SECTION, THERE SHALL BE NO SUSPENSION OR FORFEITURE OF HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.

(G) A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT EM-PLOYED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY DESIGNATE ONE OR MORE PERSONS AS BENEFICIARY TO RECEIVE ANY BENE-FITS PAYABLE UNDER THIS SECTION DUE TO HIS DEATH. THE DESIGNATION SHALL BE IN WRITING DULY EXECUTED ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIRE-MENT BOARD, SIGNED BY THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT, AND FILED WITH THE BOARD PRIOR TO HIS DEATH. THE LAST DESIGNATION OF A BENEFICIARY RE-VOKES ALL PREVIOUS DESIGNATIONS. THE PERS RETIR-ANT'S OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT'S MARRIAGE, DIVORCE, MARRIAGE DISSOLUTION, LEGAL SEPARATION, WITHDRAW-AL OF ACCOUNT, BIRTH OF HIS CHILD, OR ADOPTION OF A CHILD REVOKES ALL PREVIOUS DESIGNATIONS. IF THERE IS NO DESIGNATED BENEFICIARY, THE BENEFICIARY IS THE BENEFICIARY DETERMINED UNDER DIVISION (D) OF SEC-TION 145.43 OF THE REVISED CODE. IF ANY BENEFIT PAY-ABLE UNDER THIS SECTION DUE TO THE DEATH OF A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT IS NOT CLAIMED BY A BENEFICIARY WITHIN FIVE YEARS AFTER THE DEATH.

THE AMOUNT PAYABLE SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE INCOME FUND AND THEREAFTER PAID TO THE BENEFICIARY OR THE ESTATE OF THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYS-

TEM RETIRANT ON APPLICATION TO THE BOARD.

(H) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN DIVISION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION, IF ANY PAYMENT IS MADE BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO A PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT TO WHICH HE IS NOT ENTITLED, HE SHALL REPAY IT TO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM. IF HE FAILS TO MAKE THE REPAYMENT, THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL WITHHOLD THE AMOUNT DUE FROM ANY BENEFIT DUE THE PERS RETIRANT OR OTHER SYSTEM RETIRANT.

(I) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT THE RECEIPT OF BENEFITS BY OR ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS OF ANY PERSON WHO ON AUGUST 20, 1976, WAS RECEIVING A DISABILITY BENEFIT OR SERVICE RETIREMENT PENSION OR ALLOWANCE FROM A STATE OR MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN OHIO AND WAS A MEMBER OF ANY OTHER STATE OR MU-

NICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THIS STATE.

(J) THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

Sec. 145.382. (A) A former member receiving a retirement allowance, other than a disability allowance, from the public employees retirement system, and hereafter referred to as a retirant, may be employed, notwithstanding sections 145.381 145.38 and 145.46 of the Revised Code, if his later employment has been in a position described in any of the following categories:

- (1) A position authorized by section 101.31, 121.03, or 121.04 of the Revised Code:
- (2) A position to which appointment is made by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate;

(3) The head of a division of a state department.

A retirant employed in such a category is entitled to a retirement allowance based on his total contributions and service credit accrued

during all service as a public employee.

(B) Upon his later retirement the retirant may elect to receive retirement benefits based upon his original service and his service after reentering public service by selecting any of the optional benefit plans specified in section 145.46 of the Revised Code.

Sec. 145.43. (A) As used in this section:

- (1) "Dependent child" is a dependent child as defined in section 145.45 of the Revised Code:
- (2) "Dependent parent" is a person who is a dependent parent for the purposes of section 145.45 of the Revised Code.
- (B) Should a member die before age and service or commuted age and service retirement, his accumulated contributions, any deposits for purchase of additional annuity and any payment he has made to restore previously forfeited service credit as provided in section 145.31 of the
