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Sec. 3307.21. The treasurer of state shall furnish annually to the state teachers retirement board a sworn statement of the amount of the funds in his custody belonging to the state teachers retirement system.

The records of the board shall be open to public inspection, except for the following which shall be excluded: the personal records provided for in section 3307.29 of the Revised Code, the member's personal history record, and any information identifying, by name and address, the amount of a monthly allowance or benefit paid to a retirant, beneficiary, or survivor, except with the written authorization of the individual concerned. All medical reports and recommendations under sections 3307.42, 3307.44, and 3307.49 of the Revised Code are privileged, except that copies of such medical reports or recommendations shall be made available to the personal physician or attorney of the member upon written release received from the member or his agent, or, when necessary for the proper administration of the fund, to the board assigned physician.

Any member of the system shall be furnished with a statement of the amount to the credit of his individual account upon written request by the member. The board need not answer more than one request of a member in any one year.

THE BOARD SHALL FURNISH THE DIRECTOR OF THE OHIO STUDENT LOAN COMMISSION WITH THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER DIVISION (A) OF SECTION 3351.071 OF THE REVISED CODE.

SECTION 5. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity lies in the need to expand the improved opportunities for education made possible by guaranteeing student loans, and to ensure the repayment of such loans by individuals benefiting from the guarantees. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.
