**Municipal police department employee credit for military service.**

Sec. 742.21. A member of the fund who is an employee of the police department of a municipal corporation who, at any time after June 1, 1955, was or is called into active duty in the armed forces of the United States by action of the congress or the president of the United States for a period of continuous service longer than six months, shall, in computing years of service in such police department for the purpose of receiving pensions or benefits from the police and firemen's disability and pension fund, be given service credit, not to exceed two years, for such time served in the armed forces. Provided, such person has been discharged from such active duty under honorable conditions and has made application for reinstatement to such police department within ninety days from the date of such discharge. (*Enacted in Amended House Bill No. 642*)
