Sec. 742.35. Each employer shall pay its annual policemen POLICE employer's contribution and firemen FIREFIGHTERS employer's contribution in four equal installments promptly after such amount is certified by the secretary of the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund, as provided in sections 742.33 and 742.34 of the Revised Code. Ninety SIXTY days after such a billing is submitted THE DATE AN INSTALLMENT IS DUE, any amounts which remain unpaid shall be subject to a penalty for late payment in the amount of five per cent. In addition, interest on past due accounts and penalties may be charged at the A rate of six per cent per annum DETERMINED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD FROM THE DATE THE INSTALLMENT IS DUE TO THE DATE OF PAYMENT.

Upon certification by the board to the county auditor of an amount due from any employer within the county who is subject to this chapter, by reason of such employer's delinquency in making employer contribution payments to the fund for past years, such amount shall be withheld from such employer from any funds in the hands of the county treasurer for distribution to such employer. Upon receipt of such certification, the county auditor shall draw a warrant against such funds in favor of the fund for the amount.
