A member is ineligible to purchase or 494 obtain service credit under this section for service to be used in 495 496 the calculation of any retirement benefit currently being paid or 497 payable to the member in the future under any other retirement program or for service credit that may be purchased or obtained 498 under section 3307.761 of the Revised Code. 499
- (E) Interest charged under this section shall be calculated 500 separately for each year of service credit at the lesser of the 501 actuarial assumption rate for that year of the state teachers 502 retirement system or of the uniform retirement system to which the 503 credit was transferred under section 742.21, 742.214, 742.375, 504 5505.201, 5505.40, or 5505.41 of the Revised Code. The interest 505 shall be compounded annually.
- (F) Any amounts transferred or paid under divisions (B) and
  (C) of this section that are attributable to contributions made by
  the member or to amounts paid to purchase service credit shall be
  credited to the teachers' savings fund created under section
  3307.14 of the Revised Code. Any remaining amounts shall be
  credited to one or more of the funds created under that section as
  determined by the board.
