In accordance with Section 3307.041, Revised Code, we are submitting the proposed 2005-06 operating budget for STRS Ohio. The attached information is composed of four parts in the uniform format adopted by the five Ohio public retirement systems.

- The first page is a statement of planned operating and capital expenditures including comparisons to the 2004-05 fiscal year budget.
- The second page is a separate schedule of Retirement Board-related budget items in compliance with Section 3307.041, Revised Code. These anticipated Board expenses are included in the overall organization operating budget of \$85,953,800.
- \_ The third page is a three-year historical summary of investment assets and related management costs.
- The fourth page shows statistical information about the number of participants in STRS Ohio and the number of associates providing benefits and services.

Although the proposed operating budget total is about 1% lower than the 2004-05 budget and is the lowest budget in five years for STRS Ohio, it is intended to provide the resources needed to pay timely and accurate benefits, manage investment assets, and maintain current service levels for members and benefit recipients. Additionally, the proposed budget complies with all Retirement Board policies and seeks to demonstrate to members that STRS Ohio is managing operating expenses prudently.

We anticipate making a formal presentation to the Ohio Retirement Study Council in April. Please feel free to contact me if you need additional information.
