Ladies and Gentlemen:

Submitted in this report are the results of the <u>annual actuarial valuation</u> of the Retirement System's liabilities <u>for retirement allowances being paid</u> retirants and beneficiaries as of <u>June 30, 1972</u>.

The extensive statistical data required to make the valuation was furnished by your Executive Director and his Staff in February, using computer equipment.

The interest rate used in making the valuation was 4.5% per annum, compounded annually.

The mortality table used in making the valuation was the 1960 Group Annuity Mortality Table, set back no years for men and set back 5 years for women (please see Appendix Schedule 17). This assumption is unchanged from a year ago.

COMMENT

Based upon the results of the June 30, 1972 valuation, the mortality table in use appears to be a reasonable measure of mortality being experienced among retirants and beneficiaries. There follows the computed changes in the "Ratio of Ledger Balance to Liabilities" in each retired life fund.

ANNUITY AND PENSION RESERVE FUND

Retirants and beneficiaries receiving benefits from the Annuity and Pension Reserve Fund as of June 30, 1972 totaled 36,314, involving monthly retirement allowances of \$6,166,135.

Included in this number were 131 retirants now reemployed whose monthly retirement allowances of \$18,273 have been suspended for their periods of reemployment.

Cost of living pension increments being paid to present retirants and beneficiaries totaled \$834,067 monthly.

The ledger balance in the Annuity and Pension Reserve Fund was reported to be \$768,611,053.50 (including unexpended cost of living balance of \$787,896.20).

The computed liabilities of the Annuity and Pension Reserve Fund totaled \$741,156,768, which amount represents the lump sum present value of future retirement allowance payments from this fund to present retirants and beneficiaries.
